Through the end of 2020 and starting 2021, a common theme seen in commercial warnings and IAVMs alike is End of Life. Microsoft, Solaris, F5 and many other large companies have released EOL warnings for operating systems, software, browsers, etc. All system owners commercial and military should test and upgrade their devices and applications as soon as possible to ensure patching and updates can continue to occur. Owners should also be reviewing the source code of patches and update before pushing to ensure it is safe to do so, even when by a trusted vendor. Stay vigilant!
