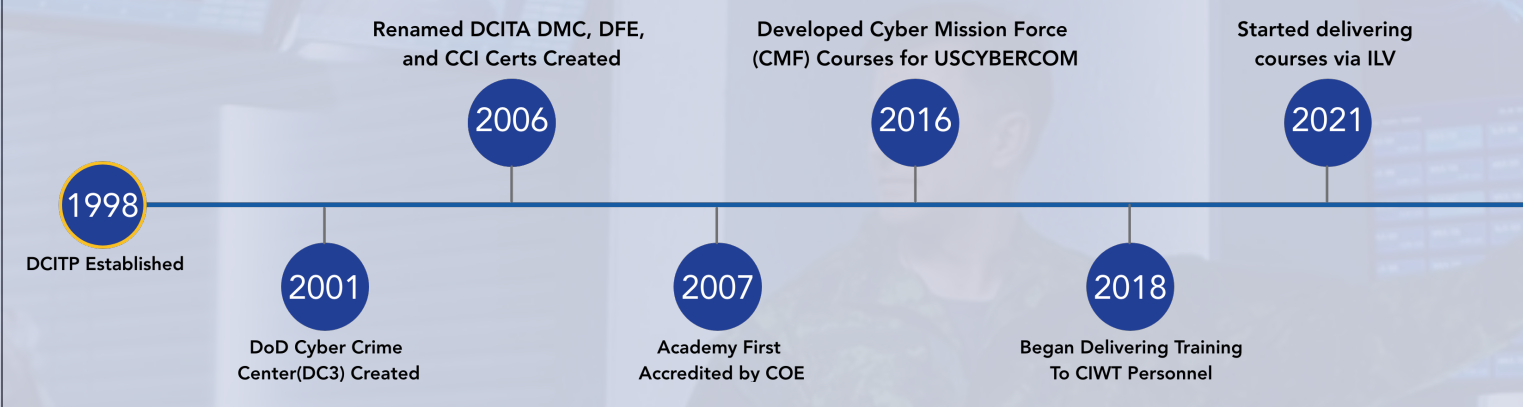


MISSION

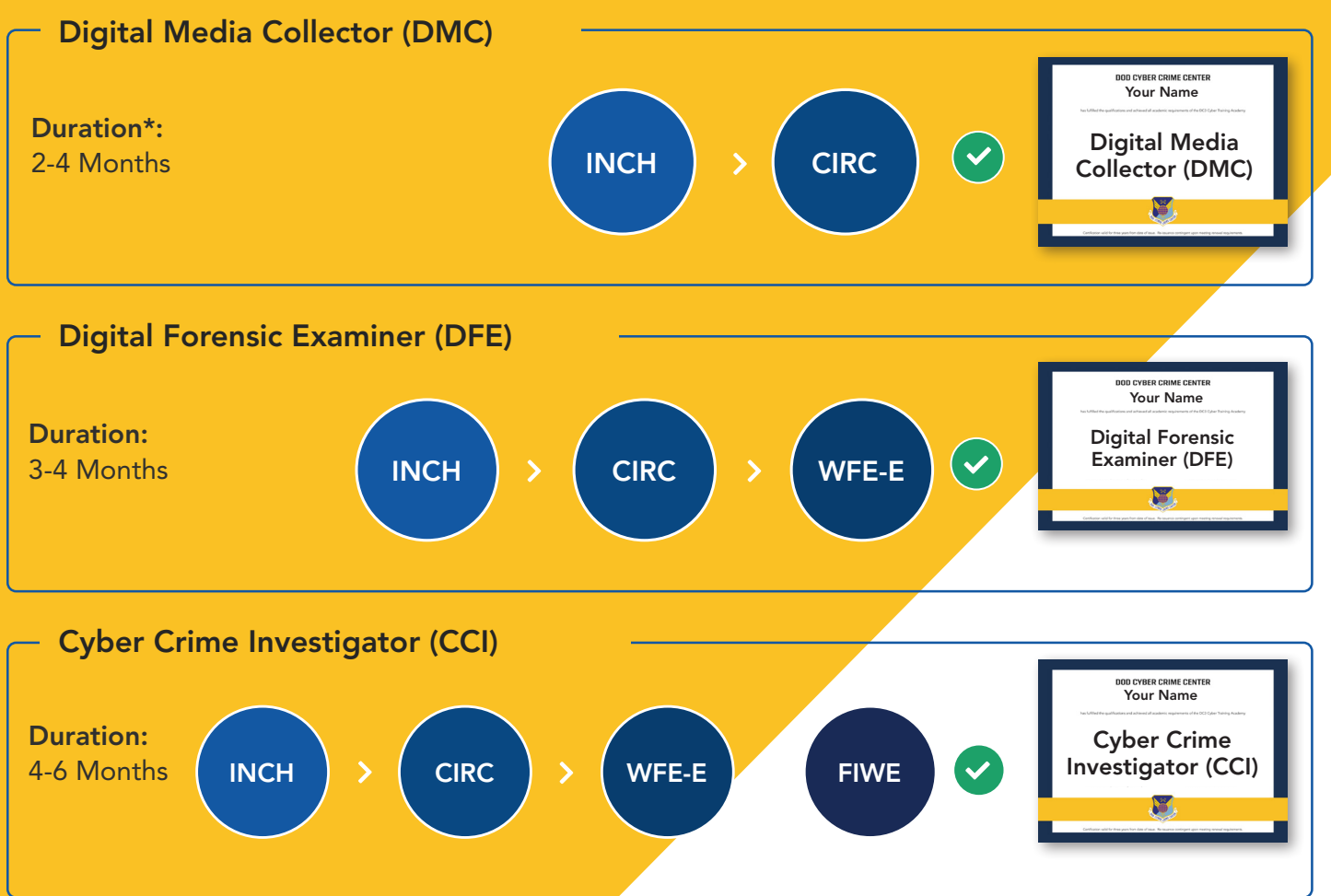

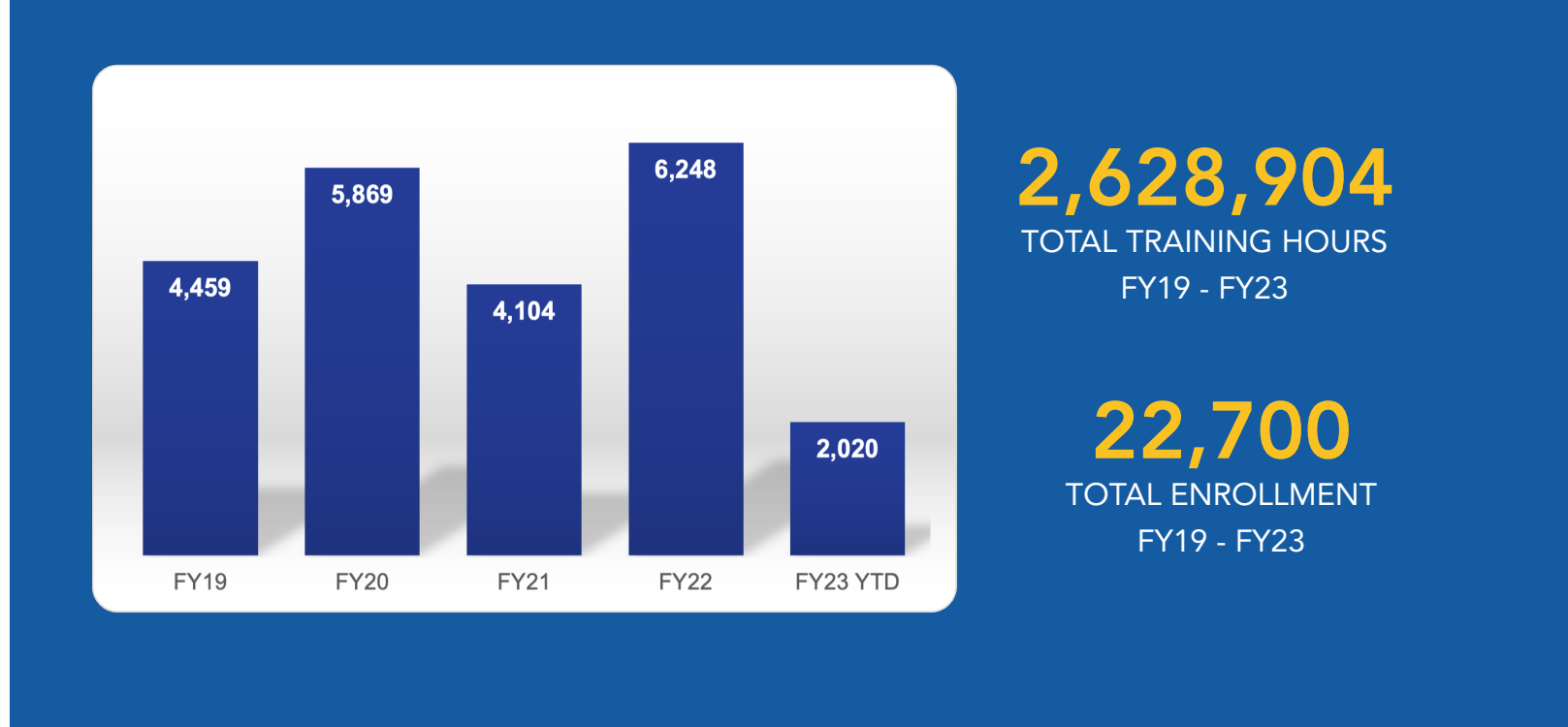
