

### AG FACT SHEET



The Analytical Group's (AG) mission is to conduct sharply focused technical and cyber intelligence analysis leveraging multiple sources of data, unique analytic tools, applications and capabilities to directly support stakeholder requirements and priorities.

Utilizing multiple reporting platforms, AG disseminates timely and relevant cyber intelligence products that enhance the overall scope, share situational awareness of the cyber threat landscape and enable mission partners' readiness and success. These products often highlight current cyber intelligence data, activity/trends, predictive analysis and technical findings with attribution.

AG's successful collaboration efforts through interagency engagements and the sharing of key cyber intelligence/operational updates have:

- Aligned operational efforts of participating stakeholders
- Fostered a cyber-intelligence community partnership
- Created a shared situational awareness network that crosses a number of missions and disciplines

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# SERVICES

**AG provides** — sharply focused technical analysis for operations and investigations in direct support of stakeholder requirements and priorities.

**AG publishes** — reports that have resulted in numerous investigation and operational leads, technical findings, and highlighted trends that enable predictive analysis.

**AG collaborates** — and elevates cyber situational awareness through a number of interagency engagements.

**AG's Quarterly Meeting** — hosts attendees from DoD and Federal-level Law Enforcement and Cyber agencies to discuss relevant and emerging cyber threat items of interest.

**AG partners** — with the DC3 Defense Industrial Base (DIB) Collaborative Information Sharing Environment (DCISE) and Cyber Forensics Lab (CFL) to protect critical technologies and information.

**AG is central** — to the release of malware signatures and decoders allowing DIB partners to defend their networks from malicious actors.

**AG provides** — products and service to Law Enforcement and Counterintelligence partners:

- Cyber Intelligence Reports—highlighting activities/trends to enable predictive analysis
- Cyber Profiles—summary of entity findings w/attribution supporting LE/CI cyber investigations and operations
- Intelligence Information Reports
- Operational Lead Reports—summary of technical findings; identification of new operational leads
